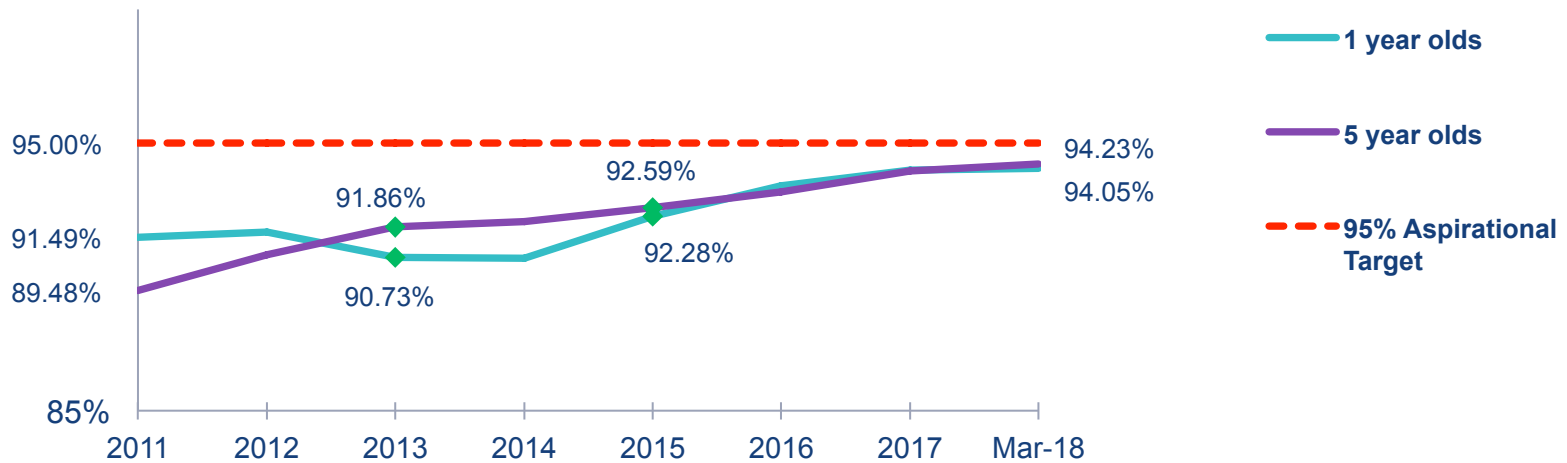
# Australian Childhood Immunisation Register to the Australian Immunisation Register

---

- Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR).
- Federal Budget 2015-16 announcements:
  - Expansion of the ACIR to capture information for ‘young adults’ under the age of 20 years (from 1 January 2016)
  - Expansion of the ACIR to capture information for all individuals regardless of age (September 2016)
- Multiple updates, vaccine additions and amendments since.

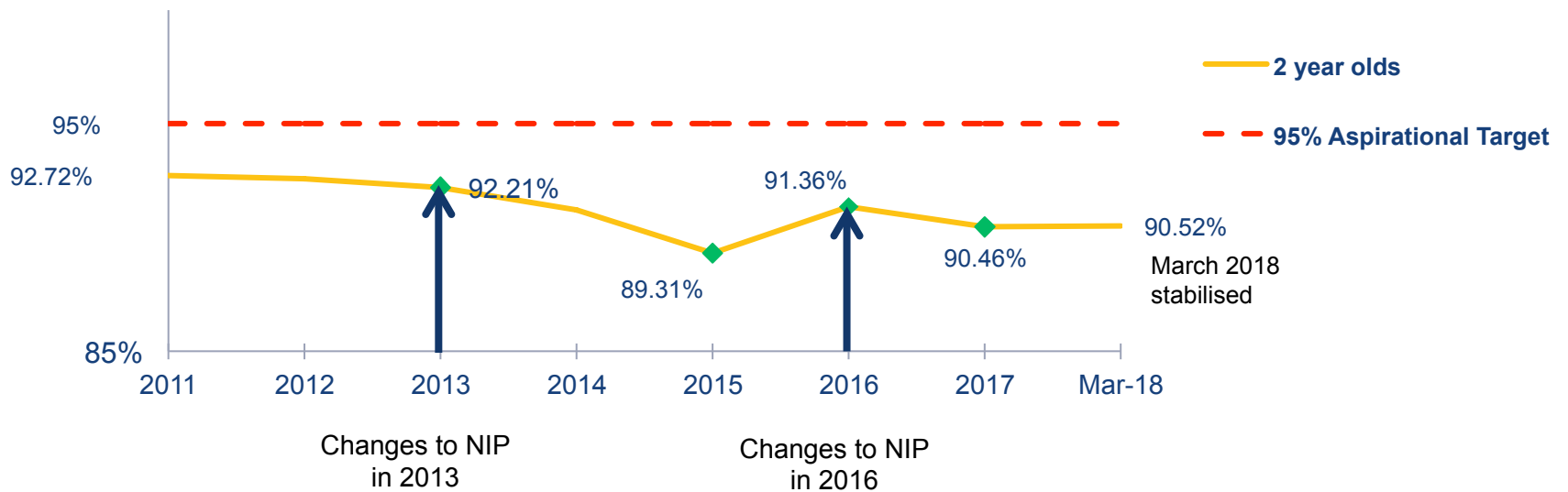


# Childhood immunisation coverage rates: 1 and 5 year olds



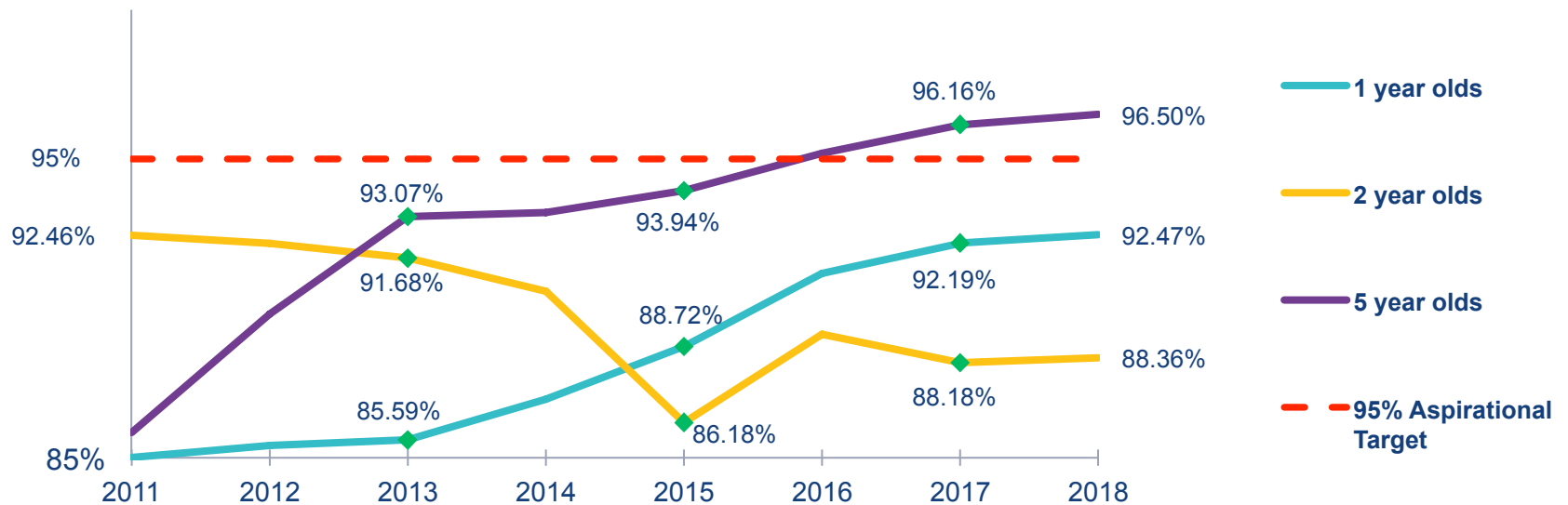


# Childhood immunisation coverage rates: 2 year olds



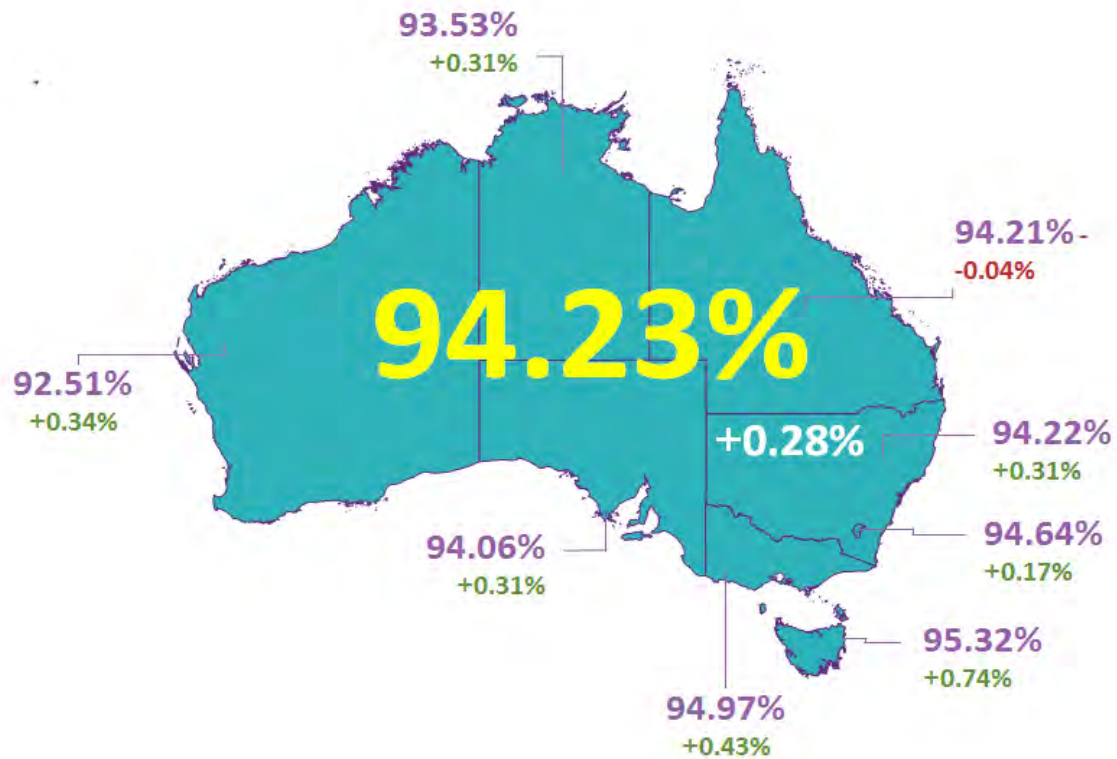


# Childhood immunisation coverage rates: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children



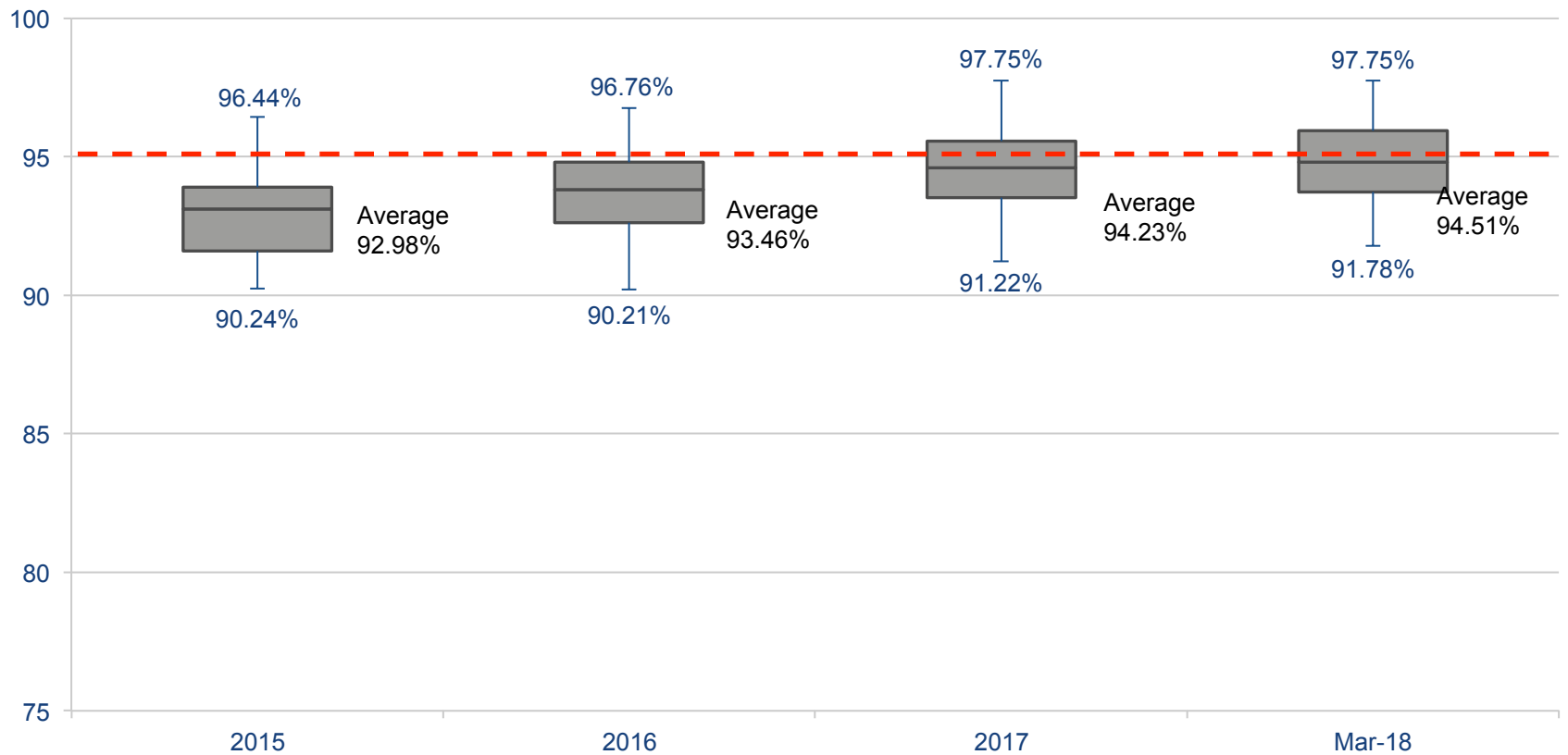


# Childhood immunisation coverage rates: 5 year olds



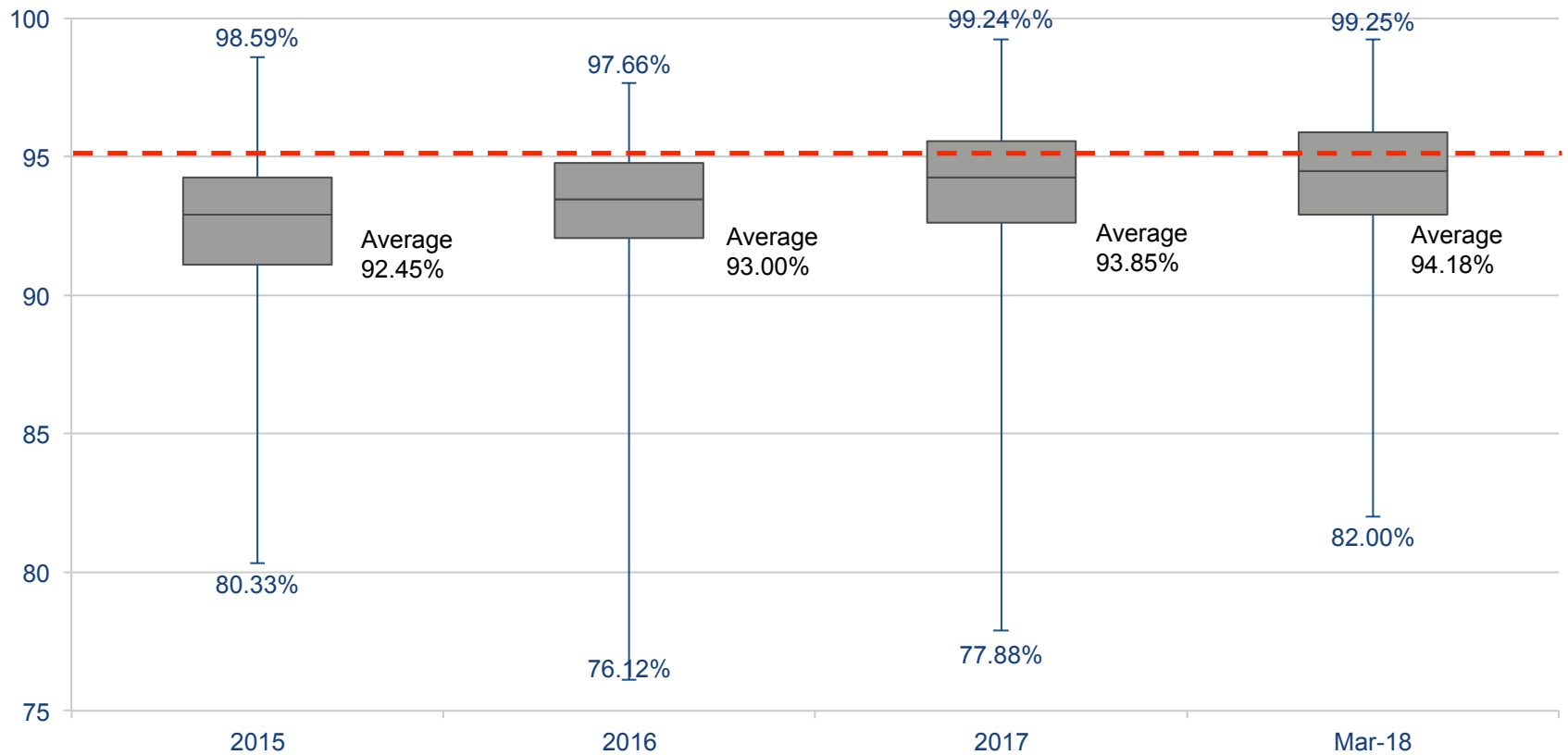


# Coverage rates: Primary Health Networks
